

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
PAULO FREIRE INSTITUTE, GRADUATE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION &
INFORMATION STUDIES, UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, LOS ANGELES
AND THE CENTRE FOR STUDIES AND INTERVENTION IN EDUCATION AND
TRAINING, INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION, UNIVERSIDADE LUSOFONA DE
HUMANIDADES E TECNOLOGIAS, LISBON, PORTUGAL.

Paulo Freire Institute, Graduate School of Education & Information Studies, University of California, Los Angeles, Los Angeles, the United States, and Centre for Studies and Intervention in Education and Training, Institute of Education, Universidade Lusófona de Humanidades e Tecnologias, hereby agree to foster academic exchange and cooperation between the two institutions.

SCOPE OF COOPERATION

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered by either institution as felt desirable and feasible on either side and that contributes to fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

Cooperation may be carried out through such activities as:

- Exchange of faculty and/or staff;
- Exchange of graduate and/or undergraduate students;
- Exchange of scientific materials, publications, and information;
- Exchange of cultural activities
- Joint conferences and academic programs;
- Joint research activities and publications.

These activities are to be carried out after mutual consultation between the two institutions or the divisions concerned thereof. Normally each institution will sign a letter of agreement setting out the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed activity and such other matters as the institutions agree are necessary for the efficient achievement of the activity.

ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITY

The Paulo Freire Institute, Graduate School of Education & Information Studies at University of California, Los Angeles and the Centre for Studies and Intervention in Education and Training, Institute of Education, Universidade Lusófona de Humanidades e Tecnologias, shall serve as coordinators of this agreement at their respective universities. Notification of any change in liaison officers may be made by letter.

AMENDMENTS, RENEWAL, AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be modified through the mutual discussion and consent of the two universities, and shall remain in effect from the date of signature for an initial period of five years. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed each year; however, after the initial period either university may terminate the agreement by giving six months written notice of such intent.





Summer Courses for Portuguese Students at UCLA
Organized by the Paulo Freire Institute, Graduate School of Education and
Information Studies-UCLA

Agreement between the Universidade Lusofona de Humanidades e Tecnologias, and the Paulo Freire Institute at GSEIS-UCLA. In the month of July, 2010, the Paulo Freire Institute at UCLA will organize a summer graduate education session, including two courses and one writing workshop for the graduate students of the Universidade Lusofona de Humanidades e Tecnologias and other Portuguese universities.

The Date of the Course Session

The date of this course session will start from July 15 to 31st, 2010, or alternatively, option B will be a month long course, starting on July 15 and ending on August 15, 2010. The location of the course session will be on UCLA campus.

The Courses of the Session

The course session will include two formal courses, which will be opened through the Faculty of Extension at UCLA. The instructor of the courses will be Prof. Carlos Alberto Torres. During the course sessions, we will also invite guest speakers from UCLA. After completing the sessions, enrolled students will get the formal transcripts from the Faculty of Extension, UCLA. The course titles are as: “Special Topics on Emerging Issues in Sociology of Education: Politics of Education”; “Special Topics in Comparative Education.”

The summer education session will also include one ESL workshop, which will be organized by the Paulo Freire Institute at UCLA. The instructors will be Research Associates at the PFI who are experts in TESL. After completing the session, enrolled students will get the formal certificate from Paulo Freire Institute at UCLA. The title of the workshop is as: “Workshop: Writing English as Second Language.”


Portuguese teachers, retired or in activity are welcome, and special sessions will be organized for them to get to know better the process of schooling in Southern California. The language of instruction is English.

The Tuition for the Course Session

The tuition of the two-week intensive course session will be US\$ 1,000 for each student, and the month long course US\$ 1.900. The tuition will cover the instructor's and teaching assistant's salaries, course readers, student's Bruin Card, access to the Gym, and complementary teaching activities. As for payment, 25% of the tuition will need to be paid by May 10th, 2010 to the Paulo Freire Institute, upon signing of this agreement. The rest of the payment will be paid to Paulo Freire Institute by July 15th, 2010. There should be a minimum of 15 students for the course to take place. Air travel and housing is the responsibility of the students.

On-campus UCLA Housing

We recommend students choose to stay in on-campus UCLA housing during the period of study. Students should process their housing application process individually and Paulo Freire Institute will provide help and counsel if needed. The related information of the on-campus housing is as the appendix of this proposal.
